


Things to do in Toronto, ON!!

The Aquarium features North America's longest underwater viewing tunnel with more than 5.7 million litres of water and over 100 interactive opportunities. Get up close and personal with three touch exhibits featuring horseshoe crabs, sharks, and rays as well as daily dive shows every 2 hours.</p> <p>This awe-inspiring attraction consists of nine carefully curated galleries showcasing a cross section of saltwater and freshwater environments from around the world – starting with species from Toronto's backyard, the Great Lakes basin.</p>

Located in Toronto, the BSM has over a thousand shoes and related artefacts on exhibit in architect Raymond Moriyama's award-winning five-floor structure.</p> <p>The BSM celebrates the style and function of footwear in four impressive galleries. Footwear on display ranges from Chinese bound foot shoes and ancient Egyptian sandals to chestnut-crushing clogs and glamorous platforms. Over 4,500 years of history and a collection of 20th-century celebrity shoes are reflected in the semi-permanent exhibition, All About Shoes. Three other galleries feature changing exhibitions, so there's always something new to see.</p>

Black Creek Pioneer Village

Self-guided multimedia tours are available in English, French, Japanese, German, Italian, Spanish, Mandarin, Korean and American Sign Language. Audio Descriptive Tours for the visually impaired are available in English and French.



There are over 10 km (six miles) of walking trails.</p> <p>The Zoo is divided into seven zoogeographic regions: Indo-Malaya, Africa, the Americas, Australasia, Eurasia, Canadian Domain and the Tundra Trek. Animals are displayed indoors in tropical pavilions and outdoors in naturalistic environments, with viewing at many levels.</p>
<p>Union Station</p> 	<p>Distance from hotel: 1.1 km 6 min drive 16 min walk</p> <p>Union Station is the premier gateway to Toronto and the busiest, most important, multimodal, passenger transportation hub in Canada, serving a quarter-million people daily.</p> <p>Union Station is connected to numerous methods of travel, including subway, commuter rail, commuter bus, passenger rail and bicycle.</p> <p>In 1975, Parks Canada designated Union Station a National Historic Site because it was, and still is, the country's finest example of a classical beaux-arts-style railway station and the largest of the great urban train stations built during the early 20th century during an era of expanding national rail networks and vigorous urban growth.</p>

<p>Universe Planetarium</p> 	<p>Website: http://www.universe.utoronto.ca/planetarium-shows/</p> <p>Think of the planetarium as an interactive movie theatre where the screen is a dome on which we can project any part of the cosmos. During most shows, the presenter begins with a tour of the night sky as it will look on the night of your show. The presenter will point out interesting features, such as constellations, planets and transient events (comets, asteroids, etc.) which will be visible that evening. The presenter will then take you away from the Earth, on a tour of the cosmos. The path you take will depend on your interests, but usually includes stops in our Solar System, a view of our Milky Way Galaxy from outside, and a trip to the farthest reaches of space.</p>
